BAL SAHYOG SCHOOL INITIATIVE



Social Umbrella foundation has been working in the field of education for several years. One of our largest initiative is work in Government aided schools of Delhi. At present we support the education of 2,000 children in many ways. Our major responsibility under the support scheme is to provide services to children such as Uniforms, Note Books, Books etc; provide infrastructure support to schools such as Black Boards, Water, Toilets, Repair, reconstruction and maintenance of the school, whenever School Administration is not able to provide adequate resources the NGO has been providing Teachers in all these schools as there is large shortfall of trained people. NGO teachers and the coordinators have been providing extra coaching and the necessary guidance and counseling to the students attending these schools. Owing to this collaborative effect, we see visible changes in the area of decrease in dropout rates, increased motivation to pursue the higher studies, better results at matriculation exams and increase in confidence.
